



Pivot Charter School Dress Code 2017-2018

Pivot Charter School believes a higher standard of dress code encourages students to have more respect for themselves and other students. Our dress code guidelines indicate appropriate school dress for normal school days. Pivot Charter School reserves the right to interpret these guidelines and/or make changes during the school year as needed. Therefore, every student who attends Pivot Charter School will wear the school uniform. Failure to wear any part of the school uniform will result in disciplinary action.

Students are expected to follow the below guidelines:

- ◆ **Shirts:** A Uniform shirt is defined as MIDDLE SCHOOL: red or grey(long or short sleeve). They may be any type of shirt that is solid in color (no plaid, logos., designs or striping) Hoodies may be worn if correct in color and hoods stay down. HIGH SCHOOL: black or grey(long or short sleeve). They may be any type of shirt that is solid in color (no plaid, logos or striping) Hoodies may be worn if correct in color and hoods stay down. NO TANKTOPS UNDER sweaters, or jackets. NO PLAID SHIRTS!
- ◆ **Pants:** All pants, shorts, and skirts must be worn with a belt through the belt loops, (if belt loops are available), worn at the natural waist, be in good repair (NO RIPS or HOLES) and have the appropriate size. Shorts and skirts must be 3 inches from the bend of the knee. Acceptable colors for uniform bottoms are black or khaki. NO SWEATPANTS OR GYM SHORTS. Jeans if BLACK, TAN or KHAKI in color may be worn. NO CAMO.
- ◆ **Shoes:** No house slippers.

No hats or bandanas
- ◆ **Exception:** Pivot Charter School may have special events which will allow for non-uniform days. (Advance notice will be sent out in regards to special event days.

Students not wearing the appropriate uniform will be written up and progressive disciplinary actions will be taken for repeat offenders.

Although we tried to be specific to all dress code situation(s), there may be issues that are left to the discretion of the faculty and administration of the school.
